

#### ITALIAN HERITAGE NEWS



On September 21, 2015, Cav. Josephine A. Maietta, President of the Association of Italian American Educators, Inc., proudly communicated, in a correspondence to Italian American educators, that the College Board has reinstated the Italian AP (Advanced Placement) examination. The exam had been discontinued as an offering for high school AP students to take and earn 3 college credits after passing the Italian AP exam. The discontinuation was largely a reflection of the fact that the College Board viewed Italian as an AP course in popular decline. The reinstatement, announced during a presentation at Hofstra University as part of the College Italian Experience Festival, represents an acknowledgement by the College Board that there has been renewed interest in studying Italian as a testament to the resilience of Italian Culture and the importance of Italy and Italians in the development of Western civilization and thought. Spearheading the drive to reinstate the Italian AP exam, thus allowing high school AP students to earn 3 college credits, were members of the Italian Consulate in New York City and the Italian Embassy in Washington D.C. as well as New York State Comptroller, Tom DiNapoli, a well-respected elected official of Italian American descent. Congratulations to all involved for making a difference and fighting to preserve and reinforce the study of Italian.
