
- A – E is assigned a main dish

Pumpkin Cheesecake

Preheat oven to 325 degrees

1 graham cracker crust (homemade or store bought)

Mix together: 2 (8 ounce) packages of cream cheese (softened)

2/3 cup white sugar

2/3 cup pumpkin puree

2 eggs

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

1 teaspoon cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon nutmeg

Pour mixed ingredients into pie crust

Bake on the middle rack for 35 - 40 minutes until set
