Dr. Davide Tanasi Presents First GCICS Zoom-Based Culture Lecture

The social gathering precautions mandated by the persistent COVID19 pandemic led GCICS to cancel scheduled cultural talks in Sarasota and transfer them, smoothly as it happened, to the Zoom social media platform. The results, fueled by the popularity of Dr. Davide Tanasi's past presentation, exceeded expectations

Fifty-two members signed up to tune into the June 26 talk "Bigger Fish to Fry: Fishing and Fish Consumption in Archaic Greek Sicily" and while we recorded 45 signins, several were watched by more than one person.

Speaking from a location in Tampa, Dr. Tanasi captured the imagination of his audience with a fascinating illustrated combination of the very old (archaeology) and the very new (bio-molecular archeology).

We learned that fish, particularly that caught in waters off Sicily, spawned a "culinary culture [that] was recognized for having a significant impact on the palates of the Greeks" who populated much of the island. Dr. Tanasi and his team worked on sites with remnants dating back to the 6th and 5th centuries BC to "reconstruct dietary habits of hundreds of individuals."

As in the past, Dr. Tanasi generously further donated his know-how and time to a Q&A period following his presentation.

We are currently exploring additional Zoom-based cultural sessions, both originating live from Italy. You will be informed as soon as these can be firmed up.


